- Days 2 – Makokola Retreat
- Days 3- Makokola Retreat

- Day 7 – Makokola Retreat
- Day 8- Transfer from Makokola to Kamuzu International Airport, Lilongwe



Arrive at Kamuzu International Airport which is located in Lilongwe, the capital city of Malawi. Lilongwe is often called the “Garden City” for its multitude of colorful trees and flowers. The transfer from Lilongwe to Makokola, Mangochi is a picturesque drive along an escarpment, giving guests their first feel of the diversity of the Malawian countryside. The journey will take you 3 hours 30 minutes.



**Day 1 – Makokola Retreat, Mangochi**

Arrive at the hotel in Mangochi, on the shore of Lake Malawi, which is home to over 300 species of fish. With its Victorian elegance and golden beach, the hotel is a haven for rest and relaxation.



**Days 2 to 5 – Makokola Retreat, Mangochi**

Days at Makokola Retreat. Its waters are the habitat of more species of fish than that of any other body of fresh water on the earth. The areas of Mangochi and Fort Johnston have an important historical heritage. Livingstone saw for the first time his lake at Mphonda that is only 10 Km south of The Makokola Retreat. Guests can absorb the Malawian culture that surrounds them by visiting the nearby attractions and admiring the local artwork and crafts around the Retreat.



#### **Day 6- Mvuu Lodge, Liwonde National Park**

Transfer to Mvuu in Liwonde national park for a 2 hour drive. Liwonde National Park is a truly evocative of a vanishing Africa. Hippos bask in slow- moving pools and crocodiles lurk on mudflats.

The trees crowd the river, pressing on it lush, and exotic green dampness. Here is the dream of Africa that has lured explorers along this very river into the heart of Africa. There are more than 600 herds of Elephant in the Park and is one of the densest Hippo concentrations in Africa. Other animals found include Sable Antelope, Waterbuck, Impala, Buffaloes, Bushbuck and Rhinos and rarely can you come across lions. Bird life is prolific. With a resident and migratory population of well over 300 species, many rare among them.

Be at Liwonde Hippo View by 1300hrs for a boat transfer on Shire River to Liwonde National Park.

Activities here include:

- Night games drives
- Nature walking trails
- Boat cruises on the River Shire
- Bird watching



#### **Day 7 – Makokola Retreat, Mangochi**

Return to Makokola, and in the afternoon, relax at the beach.

#### **Day 8 – Depart from Makokola Retreat, Mangochi**

Transfer to Kamuzu International Airport, Lilongwe 3 hours 30 minutes drive for your outbound flight.
